Gaylord Economic Development Authority Regular Meeting Minutes August 10, 2015 5:30 P.M.

I. CALL TO ORDER

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, President Chuck Klimmek called the Gaylord Economic Development Authority meeting to order in Gaylord City Hall at 5:30 P.M.

IV. MONTHLY REPORTS/UPDATES

1. Chamber Liaison:

a. Klimmek reported that the Chamber is requesting money to pay Newsom's hours.

2. Sibley County Economic Development Committee:

a. McCann reported that SEDCO is still looking for committee members for the executive board and the committee as a whole. Landaas is interested in representing the City/EDA if the new board meets at night.

3. Business Visitations:

 Wednesday, July 22, Gaylord EDA Members Jim Landaas, Steve Olmstead and EDA Coordinator Amy Newsom met with Drs. Tim and Wendy Goldsmith, owners of 4th Street Pizza and Pub. Drs. Tim and Wendy hope to have a soft opening on September 15th. 4th Street Pizza and Pub is located at 212 4th Street in the former Jimmy's Pizza building. The phone number will remain the same as when it was Jimmy's 237-2999. The menu will include microbrews, appetizers, calzones, pasta and pizza. Stop in this fall for beer and pizza!

4. SCDP Grant:

a. No update from Moline. Newsom received one complaint from a residential applicant and one complaint from a commercial applicant that contractors and inspectors are not getting out to the job sites.

5. Housing Task Force:

a. Newsom reported that the housing task force is working on a questionnaire to determine the housing needs of the city of Gaylord.

6. Downtown Design Guidelines Task Force:

a. Klimmek is waiting to move forward with this task force until the HPC ordinance is passed. The first meeting will probably be in the fall.

7. Sign and Awning Program:

a. Klimmek reported that three applications have been approved.

8. Contruction Mitigation Micro-Loan Program:

a. Klimmek reported that three loans have been approved.

V. REPORT FROM CITY COUNCIL LIAISONS (Landaas/Muchow)

1. Council Liaison Jim Landaas:

a. Landaas reported that he will be attending an RS Fiber meeting on Thursday and they still hope to have Gaylord wired this year.

2. Council Liaison Chad Muchow:

a. None.

VI. UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. 2016 Budget:

a. The EDA Board will be submitting a budget of \$56,885 to the City Council. This number includes an increase for part-time salaries and professional consultant fees.

2. MnDOT lot north of Unidoor:

- a. Newsom was contacted by Dave Haala, he is working with Farm Service Agency and was interested in the MnDOT property to build a new building for FSA.
- b. McCann reported that MnDOT is still working on a registered land survey (RLS), but that it may take another 4 months.

3. Troy Utz \$1 lot:

a. Lannoye sent Utz a letter to find out his plans and has not received a response. Utz has until November 20th, 2015 to build.

4. Frauendienst Industrial Park Property Agreement:

a. Parrott reported that building materials are out there, but a building is not up yet.

5. Residential land development packages:

a. Klimmek presented a summary of cost estimates for the former Meadow Woods development. The cost for design work and construction will be \$37,000 per lot.

6. Manufactured Home Park:

- a. McCann stated that the Department of Health looked at the mobile home park as a whole, most units were fine, just a few piles of junk and the park is encouraged to be up to today's standards.
- b. McCann spoke with Commissioner Bobbie Harder to try to set up a meeting with Harder and Tom Doughan, Sibley County representatives on the Multi-County HRA, the owners of the MHP, to discuss future plans for the park.

VII. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Messner Land / Frontage Road:

- a. Avery Grochow informed the EDA of the City's request to do a topographic map and a ghost plat of the Messner land near the school.
- b. Grochow will also meet with MnDOT to discuss a frontage road along Hwy 5/19.

2. Community and Economic Development Associate:

a. Consensus of the group to budget for an EDA consultant to assist in identifying what planning needs to be done for follow-on economic development resulting from the establishment of the medical school.

3. EDA Coordinator Performance Review:

a. Klimmek, McCann and Landaas will consist of the review committee.
