1. Call to Order

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, the meeting of the City Council was called to order by Mayor Boeder at 5:30 p.m.

2. Purpose and Timeline of the Gaylord Special Council Meeting

Mayor Boeder reported that the special council meeting was called for this evening to review, consider and vote on the approval of the proposed interim Police Services Contract with the City of Arlington. Mayor Boeder also reported that this contract is the result of negotiations between the Cities of Arlington and Gaylord whereby the City of Arlington requested that the City of Gaylord provide interim Police services not to last beyond three (3) months.

3. Specific Council Discussion Items:

3.A. Contract for Police Services with the City of Arlington

- The Interim Police Services Contract being considered for adoption at this Special Meeting
- City of Gaylord will assume responsible for any liabilities arising from providing interim Police Services to the City of Arlington
- All policing hours to be scheduled by the City of Gaylord's Chief of Police and the City of Arlington will pay Gaylord \$46.43 per each hour of Police Services provided by Gaylord
- Gaylord Police Chief to coordinate all police services activities, effective 3/29/2017
- Interim Arlington Police Chief will report directly to the Gaylord Chief of Police
- The City of Arlington City Administrator will post and recruit for an additional Police Officer, employing the City of Arlington's hiring process
- The City of Arlington will be contracting with Sibley County Sheriff's Office to supplement the Interim Police Services
- Gaylord Police Department will be responsible to respond first to take calls if available
- If the Gaylord Police Department is busy in the City of Gaylord and unable to respond, the Sibley County Sheriff's Deputies will respond to the calls if they are not busy

COUNCIL MEMBER LOSURE MOVED, COUNCIL MEMBER LANDAAS SECONDED, TO APPROVE THE INTERIM POLICE SERVICES CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF ARLINGTON, WITH ALL MEMBERS VOTIN IN FAVOR, THE MOTION CARRIED.
